## FOREXPO 2021 postpones his fair to September

The FOREXPO trade fair, which was supposed to welcome forestry and logging professionals from 16 to 18 June in Mimizan, has finally decided to postpone the event to September 2021.

Indeed, the safety of exhibitors and visitors will always be a priority for FOREXPO. However, the latest health indicators for the “Nouvelle-Aquitaine” region are not conducive to the large-scale trade fair planned in two months' time, even though the organisers had adapted the safety measures to the constraints imposed by the regulations.

The public and private partners, as well as the 240 exhibitors who had confirmed their attendance, have been warned and are maintaining their involvement in this 26th edition dedicated to the woodworking jobs, which is part of the sector's economic recovery plan.

The fair will therefore take place from 22 to 24 September 2021, in the open air, on the Mimizan site, in conditions that the organisers hope will combine professionalism and conviviality.
